The children receiving EYPP are all children with EAL. A concerted plan and focus on language and literacy means that these children are well supported.

Funding from the Early Years Pupil Premium is spent on evidence-informed training on key areas to support progress and narrow the gap between disadvantaged children and the rest (Language and literacy programme) and on overcoming individual barriers to progress (e.g. attendance or a wider Early Help offer if needed). The school does not conflate eligibility for EYPP with lower progress or ability. The impact of the EYPP is carefully and regularly monitored through our whole school review process and strategies are adapted quickly if necessary.
